CLASSES

Class 1: 70cm. Qualifier for Spring Festival Championships April 2021.

Riders in this class must be aged 14 years and under on 1st January 2020.

Class 2: 80cm. Qualifier for Spring Festival Championships April 2021.

Class 3: 90cm. Qualifier for Spring Festival Championships April 2021.

Class 4: 1.00m. Qualifier for Spring Festival Championships April 2021.

All classes will run in accordance with The Pony Club Spring Festival Arena Eventing Rules 2020/2021 and The Pony Club Eventing 2020 Rule Book. Championships will be held at Arena UK 11th/12th April.

Riders cannot compete in more than **two classes** per day. **Horses/ponies** cannot compete more than once in each class or in more than **two classes** on the day.

Competitors may qualify a maximum of two horses and/or ponies for any one Championship Class. Riders/horses/ponies and/or combination of horse and rider can qualify for more than one Championship Class.

<u>PASSING DOWN THE QUALIFICATION</u>: On the day - If a competitor is unable to go to the Championships then the qualifying places will be passed down the line. Please ensure every competitor confirms to the organiser/steward that they are intending to enter the Championships. After the Area Qualifier – If a competitor is unable to go to the Championships, they must notify The Pony Club Office as soon as possible so that their qualifying place can be passed down the line. This will only be done up until five days prior to the Championships.

ENTRY FEES: £20 per individual. £25 late entry. Entries will be limited due to daylight hours and will be accepted on a first come first served basis. **Entries online**, please follow this link www.equoevents.co.uk. **No entries on the day!**

PRIZES: Rosettes to 8th place and will be posted out.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. The competition will be a single round with two phases; a course of show jumps and one of simulated XC fences some of which may have a knock down top rail. The aim is to achieve a clear round in both phases as close to the XC optimum time as possible. The winner will be the-Individual with a clear round and the fewest time penalties.
- 2. Cross country colours or show jackets are permitted. No jewellery is allowed.
- 3. Body protectors and hats are compulsory for this competition and must meet the Pony Club standards for 2020.
- 4. Horses and ponies must be 5-years old and over.
- 5. Items of tack and saddlery must comply with Pony Club regulations. No stop watches allowed. Whips must not exceed 75cm in length.
- 6. Objections must be made to the Secretary within 5 minutes of the end of the class with a £20 deposit.
- 7. A proportion of the entry fee will only be refunded if a vet's or doctor's certificate is produced.
- 8. **Entry refund policy on Covid-19 grounds** if we are unable to run due to no first aid cover or covid-19 restrictions, refunds will be given minus an admin fee per payment.
- 9. The Organiser may, at her discretion, alter the schedule/rules as required.
- 10. The Judge's decision is final.
- 11. By entering you are agreeing to our terms and conditions. Failure to do so will result in Elimination.

COVID-19

- ALL CURRENT COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS WILL BE ADHERED TO ON THE DAY OF THE SHOW.
- 2. No admission to the show ground without an entry.
- 3. There will be no Secretary's tent but she will be on the showground ready to help.
- 4. Please keep to social distancing rules. No handshaking or hugging on greeting.
- 5. Only **ONE** responsible adult per child. If more children or ponies a maximum of **TWO** adults per family!
- 6. NO NON-RIDING SIBLINGS OR OTHER FAMILY MEMBERS PLEASE AS I AM AFRAID NO SPECTATORS ALLOWED!! We need to keep numbers on the Showground to the minimum.
- 7. There will be hand gel at entrance to all collecting rings, please remember to use.
- 8. All classes will be in a drawn order and no more than 5 in warm up area. There will be a pre-warm up area on grass.
- 9. NO PARENTS IN WARM UP ARENA, a qualified instructor will be in the ring to adjust the height of jumps and help your child if needed.

HEALTH & SAFETY

PENALTIES

SJ Phase:

Knocking down obstacle 4 penalties

First disobedience of horse 4 penalties

Second disobedience of horse in whole course 8 penalties

Third disobedience of horse in whole course **Elimination*** (Each circle or crossing tracks between fences counts as one disobedience)

First fall of rider Elimination*

Fall of Horse Elimination*

Error of course not rectified Elimination*

Failure to start or jump next fence within 60 seconds Elimination*

Starting before the Bell Elimination*

Continuing the course without a hat, or with chinstrap undone Elimination*

*Competitors eliminated in this phase may not proceed to the XC phase

XC Phase

Knocking down an obstacle 4 penalties

First refusal, run-out or circle of horse at obstacle 20 penalties

Second refusal, run-out or circle at same obstacle 40 penalties

Third refusal, run-out or circle at same obstacle **Elimination**

Four refusals around the course Elimination

Fall of horse Elimination

Fall of rider Elimination

Error of Course not rectified Elimination

Horse trapped in obstacle **Elimination**

Horse resisting rider for 60 consecutive seconds anywhere on the course Elimination

Failure to cross the finish line mounted Elimination

Continuing the course without a hat, or with chinstrap undone **Elimination**

Time will be taken overall. The optimum time will be based on a speed of 325 mpm (PC80 and below), and 375 mpm PC90 and above)

For every commenced second in excess of the optimum time 0.4 penalty

Every commenced second in excess of 5 seconds under the optimum time 0.4 penalty

Exceeding the time limit Elimination

Time limit is twice the optimum time.
