All Show jumping classes will run in accordance with The Pony Club Show Jumping 2020 Rule Book and The Pony Club Spring Festival Show Jumping Rules 2022.

ENTRY FEES: classes 1 and 2 £15 per individual; classes 3 and 4 £17 per individual; all classes after closing date £20 per individual. Entries will be limited and will be accepted on a first come first served basis. **All entries must be online**, please follow this link www.equoevents.co.uk. **No entries on the day!**

- THERE WILL BE A ONE-WAY SYSTEM IN PLACE TO ENTER AND EXIT THE ARENAS.
- ONLY 6 RIDERS IN COLLECTING RING AT ANYONE TIME. THERE WILL BE A PRE WARM-UP AREA ON GRASS IN ADJACENT FIELD.
- ONLY NEXT COMPETITOR MUST WAIT OUTSIDE RING.

RULES

- 1. Hard Hats Must be worn with chinstrap fastened at all times when mounted. Hats must be Pony Club Approved and Tagged with an Aquamarine Pony Club, British Eventing (BE) or British Riding Club (BRC) Hat Tag. Hats standard: PAS015: 1998 or 2011 with BSI Kite mark, VG1 with BSI Kite mark, Snell E2001 with the official Snell label & number, ASTM-F1163 2004a onwards with the SEI mark, AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards
- 2. Organisers reserve the right to divide or amalgamate classes according to entries.
- 3. The committee reserve the right to refuse any entry made by any person, if they so shall deem it right to do so, without giving any reason.
- 4. The Judge's decision shall be **final** at all times.
- 5. Entries will not be refunded after the closing date unless we can replace you off the waitlist.
- 6. All Show jumping classes will run under the Pony Club rules for 2020 and The Pony Club Spring Festival Show Jumping Rules 2022.
- 7. Working in for all classes, must be by competitor with a class entry on that pony.
- 8. BY ENTERING YOU ARE AGREEING TO OUR TERMS AND CONDITIONS. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN ELIMINATION

BRITISH SHOW JUMPING TABLE DEFINITIONS

Table A7. Two Phase. First phase: 7 to 9 obstacles not against the clock with a time allowed. Clear rounds continue straight on to the second phase **without** a bell being rung. Second phase: 4 to 6 obstacles which must be higher than the first phase. Competitors placed on faults and time.
