

WILTON HUNT BRANCH OF THE PONY CLUB

JUNIOR CAMP 7th - 10th AUGUST AND MINI CAMP 8th - 10th AUGUST 2019

Junior and Mini Camps will again be held at Church Bottom, Manor Farm, Broadchalke. an organic farm, by kind permission of the Jowett family.

The Post Code is **SP5 5DP**. The correct route off the road will be signed.

Please arrive between 9 and 9.45am daily. Children should then be mounted and ready to ride by 10am, when the instructors will meet and inspect their rides. The morning lessons are from then to approx 12.15pm with a mid morning break for squash and biscuits. The lunch break is from then until 1.15pm. The afternoon lessons will start at 1.30pm and end around 3.30pm.

Once any outstanding tasks are completed you are free to go home.

Parents should come to the tent each morning to check the timetable.

Unless on duty you are then free to leave, returning after 3pm to collect your child and pony.

Boxes/trailers may be left on site during the day.

However Mini Camp parents should stay all day.

On Saturday there will be a competition and details/timings will be notified at camp. All parents and friends are welcome to come and watch. This will be followed by Prize Giving.

Once camp has been cleared up you will be free to go.

Dress.

Riding hat (tagged), body protector, long sleeved white or blue shirt with a PC tie or a Branch polo shirt, and/or a Branch sweatshirt, jodhpurs/chaps/boots. Don't forget to bring a waterproof jacket.

Pony Equipment.

Saddle and bridle, girth and numnah, head collar, grooming kit, water and bucket, haynet (full), tack cleaning kit, notebook and pencil, and the PC Manual of Horsemanship. Your pony's Passport which may be checked.

You must not bring any hard feed or "treats" onto the farm as they compromise the farm's organic status. Droppings must be picked-up from around your box/trailer.

Lunch.

Don't forget to bring a picnic lunch and cold drinks. There is an excellent café/village shop next to the Queen's Head pub.

Parental Help.

A working party is needed on Tuesday 6th August to set up camp - RV on site at 3.30pm.
