The jumps will be a mixture of Show Jumps, Rustic and XC Style jumps. There will be an Optimum time set at 375m/min. In the event of equality in scores, the higher place will go to, nearest to Optimum time. More details see Rule 11. Dress XC Colours or Jacket. Body Protectors must be worn.

Classes 1, 2 & 3 - Eventer's Challenge

- a) No Entries on the day
- b) All Classes will be limited to 20 Entries will be given a start time; these will be published on the website.
- c) In the event of equality in scores, the higher place will go to, nearest to Optimum time.
- d) Dress XC Colours or Jacket. Body Protectors must be worn.
- e) The jumps will be a mixture of Show Jumps, Rustic and XC Style jumps. There will be an Optimum time set at 375m/min. In the event of equality in scores, the higher place will go to, nearest to Optimum time.

12.30am CLASS 9 RIDDEN VETERAN. Horse or Pony 16yrs or over. May be led

- Hand gel or hand washing at entrance to all collecting rings with signs to clean hands, on entering and leaving. Especially it putting up practise jumps
- All Classes will be given a time slot during the day.
- All Show Classes will be limited to 10.
- All Jumping Classes will be in a drawn order (before day) and no more than 4 in warm up area.
- **ARRIVE, COMPETE and LEAVE.**

RULES

1. Hard Hats Must be worn with chinstrap fastened at all times when mounted.
Hats must be Pony Club Approved and Tagged with an Aquamarine Pony Club, British Eventing (BE) or British Riding Club (BRC) Hat Tag. Hats standard: PAS015: 1998 or 2011 with BSI Kite mark, VG1 with BSI Kite mark, Snell E2001 with the official Snell label & number, ASTM-F1163 2004a onwards with the SEI mark, AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards
2. Ages to be taken on the date of show 18.7.20
3. Organisers reserve the right to divide or amalgamate classes according to entries.
4. The committee reserve the right to refuse any entry made by any person, if they so shall deem it right to do so, without giving any reason.
5. The Judge's decision shall be final at all times
6. Wilton PC Challenge Cups will be held for 11 months and must be returned to the organiser. No cups will be released without being signed for by a parent or suitable adult. These cups are only awarded to the highest placed Wilton member in class.
7. Entries will not be refunded unless accompanied by a Vet or Doctor's certificate.
8. All Show jumping classes will run under the Pony Club rules for 2020
9. Working in for all classes, must be by competitor with a class entry on that pony.

ENTRY REFUND POLICY ON COVID GROUNDS – IF WE ARE UNABLE TO RUN DUE TO NO FIRST AID COVER OR COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS, REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN – MINUS A £5 ADMIN FEE PER PAYMENT.
