CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- 1 This event will be run in accordance with the Rules for Pony Club Eventing 2020/21 (same rulebook) <https://pcuk.org/officials/rulebooks/>
- 2 Classes 1-3 Dressage Test must be ridden from Memory. All Dressage tests must be ridden in a snaffle bit. Class 4 Dressage test may be called and any normal bit worn.
- 3 Dressage Tests can be found on the following links <https://pcuk.org/sports/dressage/dressage-tests/>
- 4 No Horse or Pony may compete more than once.
- 5 No competitor can ride more than 2 Horses / Ponies
- 6 The Course may be walked on SATURDAY 19th June from 2pm
- 7 A proportion of the entry fee will only be refunded if a vet or doctor's certificate is produced by 12 noon on 25th June. The organisers reserve the right to retain £10 per entry should the event be cancelled.
- 8 **Entry refund policy on Covid grounds** – if we are unable to run due to no First Aid cover or Covid-19 restrictions, refunds will be given – minus an admin fee per payment.
- 9 Organisers reserve the right to divide or amalgamate classes according to entries.
- 10 Branch & Centre Team Entries to be sent by Team Coordinator. These will also be eligible for individual placing in the class.
- 11 Teams to consist of 3 or 4 members, the best 3 score counting.
- 12 Class 1 & 3: All competitors must be eligible for level as per in Rule book (page 44 for full details, quick ref below)
Class 1 – Combination of horse & rider NOT to have achieved 3 clear XC at BE100 or completed at BE Novice
Class 3 – Rider not to have represented a branch at PC90 at Area or above in any Eventing Area competition.
- 13 Hat and Body Protectors Rules
Hard Hats Must be worn with chinstrap fastened at all times when mounted.
Hats must be Pony Club Approved and Tagged with an Aquamarine Pony Club, British Eventing Hat (BE) or British Riding Club (BRC) hat tag.
Hats standard: PAS015: 1998 or 2011 with BSI Kite mark, VG1 with BSI Kite mark, Snell E2001 with the official Snell label & number, ASTM-F1163 2004a onwards with the SEI mark, AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards
A jockey skull cap with no fixed peak must be worn for Cross Country, by all competitors.
Body Protectors with a BETA 2009 Level 3 (purple) tag must be worn during XC phase

HEALTH & SAFETY:
