Junior Camp

Please arrive between 9 and 9.45am daily. The children should then be mounted and ready to ride by 10am, when the instructors will meet and inspect their rides. The morning lessons are from then to approx. 12.15pm, with a mid-morning break for drinks. The lunch break is from then until 1.15pm. Afternoon lessons will start at 1.30pm and last until 3.30pm approx. Once any outstanding tasks have been completed you are free to go home.

Parents should come to the tent each morning to check the timetable. After an early lunch on Saturday there will be a competition. Prize giving will follow and then once camp has been cleared up you will be free to go home.

Mini Camp

Thursday - to arrive in time (12noon) for picnic lunch and riding in the afternoon

Friday & Saturday: 10.30am – 3pm (dependant on weather)

Dress. Riding hat (tagged), body protector, long sleeved white or blue shirt with a PC tie or a Branch polo shirt and/or a Branch sweatshirt, jodhpurs/boots/chaps. Bring a waterproof jacket.

Pony Equipment. Saddle and bridle, girth and numnah, head collar, grooming kit, water and bucket, full haynet, tack cleaning kit. You must not bring any hard feed or “treats” onto the farm as they compromise the farm’s organic status. All droppings must be picked up from around your box/trailer.

Lunch. Don’t forget to bring a picnic lunch and cold drinks. There is an excellent village shop next to the Queen’s Head pub.

Passports. You should travel to Camp with your pony’s passport. Please forward a scanned copy of the ‘flu vaccination page to nigellefroy@tiscali.co.uk.

Covid. All Covid risk assessment procedures will be in place. If your child, or any member of your family is unwell or showing signs of Covid symptoms you must contact Sally at once.

Payment. You may pay by cheque or BACS (Wilton Hunt Brch of Pony Club 54 41 19 a/c 47104430 ref JC or MC and your name.)

Parental Help. A working party is required on Tuesday 2nd August to set up Camp – RV on site at 5pm please. Let me know if you are able to come and help.
